LLV Delegate FAQ's

1. Why do you need me?
 - a. Our delegates play an important role in the governance of LLV by electing our board of directors and making decisions for our organization at our annual meeting. They also are an important connection between our congregations and LLV so that we can be good partners in ministry.
2. But we already have delegates for LLV. I don't need to fill this out, do I?
 - a. If you have someone who has been a delegate for years and they want to continue, just write down their contact info on the form.
3. How much time will I need to commit as a delegate?
 - a. It's really up to you. We'd like you to read our monthly newsletters and share them with your congregation. We'd also like you to attend our annual meeting in March each year.
4. Who is an ideal LLV Delegate?
 - a. You! No seriously. We want you to be a delegate if you're interested in bringing your congregation and LLV closer together in ministry. If you're reading this, you're perfect for the job. You can be 14 or 84, single or married, male or female. As a communicant member of your congregation, you are an ideal delegate and can represent your ministry!
5. How will LLV communicate with me when I'm a delegate?
 - a. We prefer to use email and our web portal. But if you'd like something different, let us know.
6. Do I have to stand in front of church and talk?
 - a. No! But we'd love you to help us set up a time when we can come visit your congregation and do that for you!
7. Do I get food at events and meetings?
 - a. Of course! We're Lutheran, after all.
8. How can I best help LLV?
 - a. Two big things – pray for our residents and staff and read our newsletters. We hope you find the news interesting and help communicate our story to your congregation.
9. What's the most important for me to know? Do? Say?
 - a. Tell us how we're doing. Support us in prayer. Ask us for help with senior support and services.
10. Does my pastor help?
 - a. Your pastor has nominated you to this position. Think of it this way – your work as a delegate helps your pastor, your congregation and LLV. But we also work to help you as well.
11. Can I bring my spouse/significant other to the events/meetings?
 - a. Absolutely!
